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SEPARATE AUDIT REPORT OF THE COMPTROLLER AND AUDITOR GENERAL OF INDIA ON THE ACCOUNTS OF CENTRAL SILK BOARD, BANGALORE FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2016

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Central Silk Board, Bangalore as at 31 March 2016 and the Income & Expenditure Account/Receipt & Payment Account for the year ended as on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with Section 12 of the Central Silk Board Act, 1948. These financial statements include the accounts of 27 units of the Board. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Board's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

- 2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules and Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects etc., if any, are reported through inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Report separately.
- 3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amount and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.
- 4. Based on our audit, we report that:
- We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.
- ii. The Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account/Receipt & Payment Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format prescribed by the Ministry of Finance.
- iii. In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by the Central Silk Board as required under Section 12 of the Central Silk Board Act, 1948 in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- iv. We further report that:
- A) Income and Expenditure Account

Income - Grants from Government of India (Sch.13) ₹455.90 erore Expenditure - Expenditure on Grants, Subsidies etc (Sch.22) ₹83.52 erore

The Board has recognized the full amount of revenue grants received during the year as Income and considered the unspent grants at the end of the year as expenditure by crediting the account head 'Amount Received for Disbursement' under Other Liabilities which is not in accordance with the provisions of Accounting Standard 12 issued by Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, which stipulates that revenue grants to the extent actually mounted as expenditure should be recognized as income and remaining unspent grants shown under Liabilities. The accounting treatment adopted by the Board has resulted in

overstatement of income as well as expenditure by ₹9.84 erore. This has also resulted in non-provisioning of interest at the rate of 10 percent per annum on the unspent amount of the grants.

B) General

The original land deeds of Central Sericultural Research and Training Institute, Berhampore (63.08 acres) and RSRS unit, Kalimpong were not available with the Board.

C) Grants-in-Aid

The Board is financed by Grants-in-Aid from the Government of India. During the year 2015-16, the Board received Grant-in-Aid of ₹480.18 crore and utilised ₹470.34 crore leaving a balance of ₹9.84 crore.

Deficiencies which have not been included in the Audit Report have been brought to the notice of the Member Secretary, Central Silk Board, Bangalore through a Management Letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.

- v. Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance sheet and Income & Expenditure Account/Receipt & Payment Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Polices and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India.

 - b. In so far as it relates to Income & Expenditure Account, of the deficit for the year ended as on that date.

EXPLANATORY NOTE ON THE C & A G'S SEPARATE AUDIT REPORT ON THE ACCOUNTS OF THE CENTRAL SILK BOARD, BANGALORE FOR THE YEAR 2015-16

A) Income and Expenditure Account

Income-Grants from Government of India (Sch.13) ₹ 455.90 crore Expenditure-Expenditure on Grants, Subsidies etc (Sch.22)₹ 83.52 crore

CSB had received ₹480.18 crore during the year 2015-16 as Grants in Aid. Out of which ₹302.08 crore was received under Non-Plan and ₹ 178.10 crore under Plan. A sum of ₹ 9.84 crore was released to the CSB units for the implementation of critical components of erstwhile CDP Scheme under the Central Sector Scheme namely "Integrated Scheme for Development of Silk Industry" during the year 2015-16 as approved by the EFC in its meeting held on 01.06.2016.

The sum of \P 9.84 crore is in the nature of committed expenditure (both revenue & capital) as per the approved scheme and the same were retained by the CSB Units as per the permission granted by the Ministry vide letter No. G-20008/5/08 B&A dated March 2008 to CSB for booking the expenditure in the year of release for meeting the committed nature of expenditure and not to surrender as unspent grants. Hence, CSB had not surrendered a sum of Rs.9.84 crores during the year 2015-16 in view of the above Ministry's permission after taking into account the nature of expenditure.

CSB had recognised the Plan Grants received during the year as Income in view of the Ministry's permission letter dated March, 2008. The same method of disclosing the Revenue Grants received from the Ministry is followed consistently and disclosed as Income in the Income and Expenditure Account. The said accounting treatment had withstood the test of audit of earlier years.

The provision of interest at the rate of 10% p.a on the unspent amount of Grants arise only in case of surrender of Unspent Grants to the Ministry. However the said amount is being utilised for the committed expenditure as per the approved scheme as said above. The terms of the GIA sanctioned says "If the Grantee fails to utilize the Grant for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the Grantee will be required to refund the amounts of Grants with interest thereon at the rate of 10% p.a ".

CSB had not surrendered any amount as Unspent Grants during the year 2015-16, hence the provision of interest at the rate of 10% p.a on the Unspent Grants does not arise. Further, it is to emphasise that the said amount is being utilised.



B) General

The original land deed of CSR&TI, Berhampore had already been forwarded by Land and Land Revenue Department, Government of West Bengal to the Ministry of Commerce, GOI vide Letter No. 395/L.R dated 7th January, 1967.

The efforts are also being made to obtain the copy of the said land deed from the Government of West Bengal in respect of land pertaining to CSR&TI, Berhampore and RSRS, Kalimpong.

C. Grant-in-Aid:

During the year 2015-16, Central Silk Board had received the Grants in aid of ₹.480.18 crores. The Board had utilized the grants—for meeting the committed expenditure of approved schemes including the sum of ₹.9.84 crores under Amount Received for Disbursement.

ANNUAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR 2015 - 2016

I. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

1. FIXED ASSETS:

- a. Fixed Assets are shown at Actual Cost, all the incidental expenses incurred in acquiring assets are also added to the assets.
- b. Almost all the Assets acquired ON free of cost are valued on the basis of particulars available and information furnished by the respective authorities.
- C. The Fixed Assets include unserviceable articles which could not be quantified.
- d. Unserviceable Fixed Assets are disposed off as per the procedures laid down in the General Financial Rules and Book values are adjusted in the Balance Sheet.

2. **DEPRECIATION**:

Depreciation on the Assets is provided on Straight line method. The Depreciation on the additions of assets during the year is provided on pro-rata basis, i.e., full year depreciation is charged for those additions made on or before 30^{th} September and half year depreciation for additions made on or after 1^{st} October. The rates of depreciation adopted are : [1] Land – Nil, [2] Buildings and Other Original Works – 1.63 %, [3] Tools, Plant and Machinery – 4.75 %, [4 (i)] Furniture and Office Equipments – 6.33 %, [4 (ii)] Electronic Data Processors including Computers & Printers – 16.21%, [5] Vehicles – 9.50 %, [6] Fans and Fixture – 6.33 % and [7] Library Books – 4.75 %.

3. RECEIPTS & PAYMENTS ACCOUNT:

Actual Expenses paid and receipts received are taken in the Receipts & Payment Account.

4. LOANS & ADVANCES:

All employee's loans and advances are shown in the Books of Accounts as per the General Financial Rules.

5 RETIREMENT BENEFITS:

Retirement Benefits are booked as and when paid.

6. INCOME & EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT:

The Income & Expenditure Account is prepared on accrual basis.

7. The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost basis.

8. EARMARKED FUNDS:

There are Earmarked Funds at CSB. The investments are made out of the said funds. The Income / Interest earned out of the investments of the said funds are directly credited to the respective funds as per the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles. Further, the Income accrued to these Earmarked Funds by way of sales, etc are also directly credited to the said funds since the same are not CSB's Income.

9. PROFORMA ACCOUNTS:

Govt. of India has sanctioned specific funds for the operating the Raw Material Banks and also the Price Stabilization Schemes. The Annual Accounts Statements of the above said specific funds are separately shown in the Annual Accounts of the CSB which is conventionally & consistently followed.

10. VALUATION OF CLOSING STOCK

The value of the closing stock of Dfls at the units is valued at Market price or cost price whichever less.

11. SALES

Sales are recognized when the substantial ownership is transferred to the Buyer. Sales are stated exclusive of returns and applicable discounts and allowances.

12. SUNDRY DEBTORS:

The Sundry Debtors include the amounts pertaining to the earlier years. The details of the write off proposals will be indicated under Notes on Accounts as soon as the proposals are approved by the Competent Authority and sent to the Ministry for its approval.

13. EPF:

The Skilled Farm Workers of CSB are covered under Employees Provident Fund Act and Misc. Provisions Act,1952 and accordingly contributions are paid.

14. PENSIONARY BENEFITS:

The terminal benefits including Pension requirements are included in the Budget Estimates which were considered and sanctioned by the Ministry and met out of the Grants-in-Aid.
