Terms & References of the Nodal Officers

Nodal Officers duty and responsibilities:

1. Nodal Officers nominated for the State would serve as single window for all State specific issues on sericulture.
2. He will closely monitor the implementation of Central Sector Scheme, Convergence Programme, plantation status, Silkworm Seed requirement, Silkworm crop programme and submit report regularly.
3. He will represent CSB in all meetings of the state where project is sanctioned, progress reviewed and policy decisions are taken viz., PMC, SLSCC, Seed Action Plan, Convergence programme, Marketing etc.
4. Nodal Officer will keep a close contact with the in-charge officer of Regional Offices dealing the concerned States and S&F Section of Central Office for maintenance of the sericulture statistics/data base up to date.
5. Nodal Officer should develop proper linkages with DOSs and CSB units in the States. Any changes, to be immediately brought to the notice of the Competent authority.
6. Nodal Officer will submit monthly report on state's physical and financial progress and status of sericulture.

Terms of the Nodal Officers will be reviewed annually. The periodical review of the activities performed by the above nominated Nodal Officers would be done by the Member Secretary.
