### THE SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019

No. 8 OF 2019

[6th July, 2019.]

An Act to amend the Special Economic Zones Act, 2005.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Seventieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—
